

# How to identify browser type in Dynatrace Recorder

## Information:

Environment

Symptoms
Sometimes different browsers have different behaviors (for example, the index of frames might be different) when interpreting a piece of HTML source code.
Solution
<p>For example, to use a script for both the IE Agent and the Firefox Agent when the behavior is different depending on the browser type:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Add a Custom action in the script timeline.</li><li>2. Put the following code in the Custom action: "<pre>var ua = window.navigator.userAgent.toLowerCase(); IF (ua.indexOf("IE")!=-1)     {.....} else     {.....} "</pre></li><li>3. Put the code for the behavior of the IE Agent inside the braces following the IF statement.</li><li>4. Put the code for the behavior of the Firefox Agent inside the braces following the ELSE statement.</li></ol>
