

How to uninstall the Private Peer

Complete this procedure to remove Private Last Mile from your system.

1. Exit Private Last Mile if it is running.
2. Stop the **Gomez peer** service.
Windows **Control Panel > Administrative Tools > Services**.
3. Launch the uninstaller.

From the Windows **Start** menu, select **All Programs > Dynatrace Peer > Uninstall Private Last Mile**.

4. If you installed the version of the private peer that includes a built-in virtual machine, you may be prompted to uninstall the VMWare player.

During the uninstall process, a message box may appear, giving you the option of uninstalling the VMWare player. Click **Yes** to uninstall this component.
