

# How to download data based on a daily timeframe

Solution
<p>You can display any Interactive Chart in many different ways. You can export chart data in Comma Separated Value (CSV) or XLS format. To display a chart based on a daily timeframe:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>In the Dynatrace Portal, display the Interactive Chart. For details, see <a href="#">Interactive Charts</a> in the documentation.</li><li>The default time range is <b>Last 24 Hours</b>. To change the time range, click <b>Last 24 Hours</b> and selected the desired value from the list. The "daily" options are:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>Last 24 Hours</b> – From yesterday through the current time.</li><li><b>Today</b> – From midnight through the current time.</li><li><b>Yesterday</b> – The 24-hour period of the previous day.</li></ul></li><li>The chart is updated automatically for the new time range. Note that the x-axis displays the time for Greenwich Mean Time (GMT), not your local time zone.</li></ol> <p>To export the chart data:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Click <b>Action</b> above the top right corner of the chart, select <b>Export</b>, then select the format (CSV or XLS).</li><li>In the <b>Save As</b> dialog box, navigate to the directory where you want to save the file, and click <b>Save</b>.</li></ol>
